Create an insert for the Bloomfield Township Welcome brochure





Short Term Objective #2

Increase patron awareness through interdepartmental displays





Short Term Objective #3

Send a notice – "You haven't used your library card recently – to all Bloomfield Township residents who have not used their BTPL library card in the last year

Invite Bloomfield Township organizations to meet at BTPL

Offer programming during non-traditional library hours

Create programming for BCTV

Give away merchandise in the Library with our new logo





Short Term Objective #7b

Sell merchandise in the Library with our new logo

Develop a K–12 BHS text book collection at the Bloomfield Township Public Library





Short Term Objective #3

Organize and host an annual meeting/breakfast with Bloomfield Hills Schools media centers





Short Term Objective #4

Initiate the sharing of library resources between BTPL and Bloomfield Hills Schools media centers





Short Term Objective #5

Co-sponsor BTPL and Bloomfield Hills Schools media center programs





Partnerships:

More partnerships with parents, with other school districts, and with other libraries will be developed in fiscal year 2011-12 and beyond.





Prioritized access and convenience for residents to Library collections and services.





Objective: Prioritize **access** and **convenience** for residents to the Bloomfield Township Public Library's Collections and Services





Residents Currently Enjoy Priority Convenience and Access in many areas

- •Residents can check out up to 150 items at one time
- •Immediate registration to Library programs and clubs
- •Reserve meeting rooms for outside groups
- Access to online databases from remote sites
- Access to the Cranbrook Educational Community
- Free Access to the Burton Historical Collection



A number of topics relative to *Access* were considered by the Task Force

- Library Hours
- Parking
- Technology Resources
- Study Rooms
- Library Catalog Computer Screens
- Interlibrary loan services and related charges
- Library rental materials and related fees
- Library Staffing (HR)
- Access from Home





A Number of Topics Relative to *Convenience* were considered by the Task Force

- Hours
- Location of Materials and Collections
- Specialized Services for patrons/seniors/handicapped/nursing homes/homebound
- Concierge Services
- Community Drop Boxes
- Valet Service
- Materials pickup when the library is closed





Ultimately the Task Force agreed to do in-depth studies on five objectives

- Improved Signage
- A Time Management System for Computers and Wi-Fi
- Limited Renewals for Non-Residents
- Library Books By Mail Service
- A Drive-up Materials Pick-Up Window



Short Term Objective #1

Improve signage

Background

The task force undertook onsite observations and visits to other libraries. The conclusion was BTPL needs to improve both exterior signage and interior signage. The exterior signs are difficult to read and the placement is inconsistent. The Interior signs are oftentimes difficult to find, provide little direction, are not "material specific" enough and don't provide a "user friendly consistency.





Short Term Objective #1

Improve signage

Features and Benefits – Exterior Signage

Features: Make them larger and easier to read. Placement on the

same side of the driveway. Reposition sign at the SW corner

to provide parking clearance.

Benefits: Improved traffic flow to the book return drive through - less

driver frustration and improved safety.



Short Term Objective #1

Improve signage

Features and Benefits - Internal Signage

Install lobby kiosk. "Brand" signage by incorporating new logo. Printed maps at service desks. Revise all signs to Features:

improve visibility. Make signage more descriptive and "sized

to fit." Place material location maps on computer screen

catalogs.

Empower patrons to be more self sufficient. Reduce "where Benefits:

is it?" questions, freeing up staff



Short Term Objective #2

A Time Management System for Computers and Wi-Fi

Background

Implement a system allowing more control over patron usage – consistent with the idea of giving township residents priority access to the library resources



Short Term Objective #2

A Time Management System for Computers and Wi-Fi

Features and Benefits

Features: Electronically places time limits on use, validates library

cards, monitors adult material, allows for credit card

payments. Creates a visitor pass with or without fees.

Creates a billing account and bills for printing.

Benefits: Regulates/prioritizes waiting time for residents. Reduces

printing costs. Electronically generates reports. Minimizes staff involvement. Maintained by BTPL systems department.





Short Term Objective #3

Limited renewals for nonresidents

Background

The task force feels library materials can be made more available to residents by limiting renewals for nonresidents from the current three renewals to one renewal. This is a change that can be made easily and with little cost.





Short Term Objective #3

Limited renewals for nonresidents

Features and Benefits

Features: Library staff from systems and circulation can implement the

change. Renewal limit will be automated within the system

Benefits: Increased access to material for residents. New renewal

policy will be in line with statewide interlibrary loan policy.

Easy and cost effective to implement and will require a

minimum amount of staff time





Short Term Objective #4

Books by Mail Service

Background

This "Netflix" type of service has been studied using a strategic planning focus group which viewed the concept favorably and indicated a willingness to pay for such a service. Currently the BTPL outreach program serves only senior facilities and nursing homes. Implementing this type of program will allow the library to serve other patrons who may not be able to physically visit the library





Short Term Objective #4

Books by Mail Service

Features and Benefits

Features: Service available to residents only and to any resident who is

physically unable to visit the library. Materials sent only to Bloomfield Township zip codes. Patrons can pay by credit

card or by using a "my account" feature

Benefits: All residents will have access to materials, particularly the

residential elderly, disabled and infirm. Library "open" hours

are effectively eliminated for residents





Short Term Objective #5

Drive up Materials Pick up Window

Background

Other community libraries were visited to study the effectiveness of a staffed drive up window. The task force recognizes the barriers to accomplishing this objective in the short term, particularly the costs involved for physical plant structural modifications. Yet, we believe that it is such a significant access and convenience improvement that an indepth study for such a change should be undertaken as quickly as possible.





Short Term Objective #5

Drive up Materials Pick up Window

Features and Benefits

Incorporation of a "bank teller" type window with a roof Features:

overhang, a call button to manage staffing, book shelves for storing "on hold" library material and a "call ahead" process

for patrons to request material.

Provides parking lot "relief." Improved pick up access and Benefits:

convenience for patrons. Eliminates need for staff to provide "concierge" service. Convenience will potentially increase

overall library materials use by patrons.
